A fierce and strong lion broke a fence and got into a Cape Town holiday camp, damaging a taxi parked nearby.

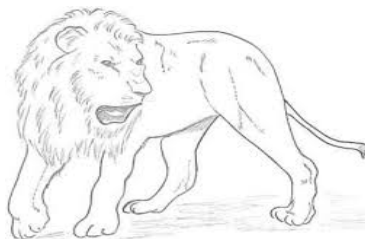

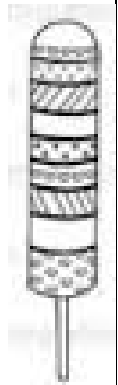

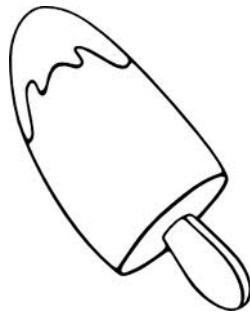
